Oral Hygiene Products

Toothbrush Kits

Biotene Drinking Water Concentrate

A flavorless, odorless liquid, Biotene is added daily to your pet's drinking water and contains specially formulated enzymes that help to remove plaque and inhibit nasty odor-causing bacteria.

Dental Chews

Healthy teeth can be as simple as giving your pet a daily treat. These specially formulated chewies are coated with a chlorhexidine solution that helps reduce plaque and tartar.

Maxiguard Oral Cleansing Gel

A tasteless gel that can be applied to your pet's teeth daily to help reduce plaque buildup and freshen breath with or without brushing. For best results Maxiguard should be used daily.

Porphyromonas Bacterin Dental Vaccine

Currently available only for dogs, the "dental" vaccine works by helping to fight the bacteria that live in your dog's gum line that cause periodontal disease, tooth loss and bone damage. It is the first and only vaccine to aid in the prevention of canine periodontitis. The vaccine is initially administered to your dog in two doses given 3 weeks apart, then boosted on an annual basis.

OraVet Dental Sealant

OraVet is a barrier sealant gel that is initially applied directly after a professional dental cleaning. The barrier is then maintained with a weekly at-home application.
